



Maintenance Handy Person

The Toronto Pan Am Sports Centre Inc. is currently seeking a Part-Time Maintenance Handy Person to join our team!

Reporting to the Maintenance Supervisor, the Maintenance Handy Person will be required to perform preventive maintenance and corrective repair of buildings, industrial systems, and equipment both indoors and outdoors as well as to perform grounds duties that include lawn and green roof maintenance as well as parking equipment maintenance. Working under limited supervision, the Maintenance Handy Person will assist with monitoring building systems and perform carpentry, minor plumbing, minor electrical, painting, technical cleaning, roofing, window washing, pothole filling, weeding, etc. The maintenance Handy Person worker will also assist the Building Operator with preventative maintenance tasks relating to the building's mechanical operations.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Basic carpentry, minor plumbing, minor electrical work;
- Assists Building Operator with mechanical operations including operations using a computerized Building Automations System (BAS);
- Performs basic chemical and temperature testing and maintains accurate records;
- Assists with operation and maintenance of lighting control systems and maintenance systems;
- Assists with testing and maintaining all building fire and life safety systems;
- Promptly responds to building emergencies and performs preventative maintenance to maintain tenant comfort and mitigate building and tenant damages, which includes primary response to fire alarms;
- Contributes to the preventative maintenance program and performs accurate record keeping;
- Assists with swimming pool filtration and disinfection operations;
- Some specialized cleaning (e.g. swimming pool bulkhead slats, cleaning of underwater vacuum components, high cleaning, etc.);
- Repairs and maintains swimming pool equipment and other sporting equipment;
- Assists with conducting facility inspections and inventories;
- Performs minor repairs on parking equipment and performs grounds keeping activities such as weeding garden beds and green roof as well as lawn cutting;
- Assists trade people as required and performs other related work as assigned; and
- Assists with ensuring compliance with health and safety legislation, fire code, TSSA, and other mechanical and other operations legislation and standards and other duties as required.

The successful candidate will possess the following qualifications:

- Must have completed secondary school; and
- Must have current Standard First Aid certification.
- Pool Operator certificate, Building Environmental Systems certificate, BOMI Systems Maintenance Technician (SMT) designation and/or SCUBA diving certificates are considered assets.
- License as a skilled trade (e.g. electrician or plumber) is considered an asset.

Experience

- Minimum of three (3) years of relevant maintenance experience.
- Facility maintenance experience specific to an athletic complex is an asset.
- Experience in carpentry, minor electrical work, window washing, minor plumbing, drywall and painting, grounds work, and other maintenance work are all assets.

Skills and Other

- Very familiar with maintenance tools and power tools is essential;
- An ability to read and perform tasks outlined in technical manuals and publications;
- Solid interpersonal skills with the ability to deal courteously with the public;
- Must be physically capable of performing required duties;
- Must be comfortable working from heights (ladders and lifting devices);
- Ability to maintain accurate records and to communicate effectively in English, verbally and in writing with staff, contractors, trades people, etc.;
- Basic proficiency with computer applications such as email, Windows OS, MS Word and MS Excel and AutoCAD skills are an asset;
- Must be familiar with the Occupational Health and Safety Act;
- Able to work days, evenings and weekends (7am-7pm and 7pm-7am); and
- Able to work additional hours when necessary.

Three professional references will be required and a police vulnerable check will be completed for the successful candidate.
